Objectives:

The primary objective of this course is to prepare and train future executives, as well as company directors, public administration leaders, and international organization leaders, to better understand the world of oil and energy by instructing the students on the legal, financial and geopolitical issues concerned.

Furthermore, students are taught to analyze the global geopolitics of the oil and energy world with particular concern for an essential element in this field: the correct approach to the management of power struggles.

The third objective is to help our students achieve full understanding of real world strategies in the development of oil and other energies, and most importantly how to apply those strategies efficiently.

Finally students will be faced with the challenges of implementing economic reconversion programs in a world where oil revenues are decreasing.

IPAG

The IPAG group welcomes 1350 students (including 200 international students) in two centers located in Paris and Nice. Its teaching staff includes 25 permanent teachers, 230 external participants and another 20 visiting professors. IPAG, an offshoot of the Collège des Sciences Sociales et Economiques, was founded in 1965 and is an independent association with a strong international network of more than 90 business schools and 5600 alumni. Its five-year diploma is accredited by the French Ministry of National Education.

ADMISSION

Admission requirements

Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in law or economics and management, or a bachelor's degree from recognized educational institution and have an adequate level of English.

An interview with the Dean of the School of Economics and Management will be made for further evaluation of the candidate's analytical thinking, interpersonal, communication skills, readiness and capability to the program.

Admitted student will be notified of their acceptance after evaluative interview.

Deadline for application: September 05, 2009.

Tuition fees

The overall cost of Dual MBA program is 8000 € for the 2009/2010 academic year. Student are required to pay the receptive tuition fee before the start of each term or course seminar
